School Calendar:

School Supplies:

Please note that students in Kindergarten and up are requested to bring an "earthquake" supplies kit. We have community earthquake supplies for our preschool students, but feel that older kids should have their own items on hand. Please bring all supplies on the first day of school.

Two changes will be starting this fall:

- FACTS tuition system **will send you** an invite for you to set up your payment plan. All payment plans need to be set up by August 5th.
- **Tuition contracts and student enrollment forms need to be submitted to the office by August 5th for your child to be admitted on the first day of school.** You can mail or contact the office at info@maayanpdx.org to drop off anything that is still needed.
- Only first grade is a peanut free classroom this year.
